## Sulfinpyrazone

Sulfinpyrazone should be taken two times a day, with an initial of 50mg to 200mg, and also after that then 200mg to be able to 400mg two times every single day. If you happen to drink lots of water, the dose may be lower. The negative effects of the prescription drug include problem in breathing, swollen glands and fevers. Some others can experience bruising, hemorrhaging, sore throat and ulcers.

## Benzbromarone
